To provide a supply route for the Roman legions fighting in Dacia, Emperor Trajan ordered the construction of a bridge over the Danube.

It was built between 103 and 105 A.D., by Apollodorus of Damascus, the greek architect who will make later the Trajan's Column in Rome.
