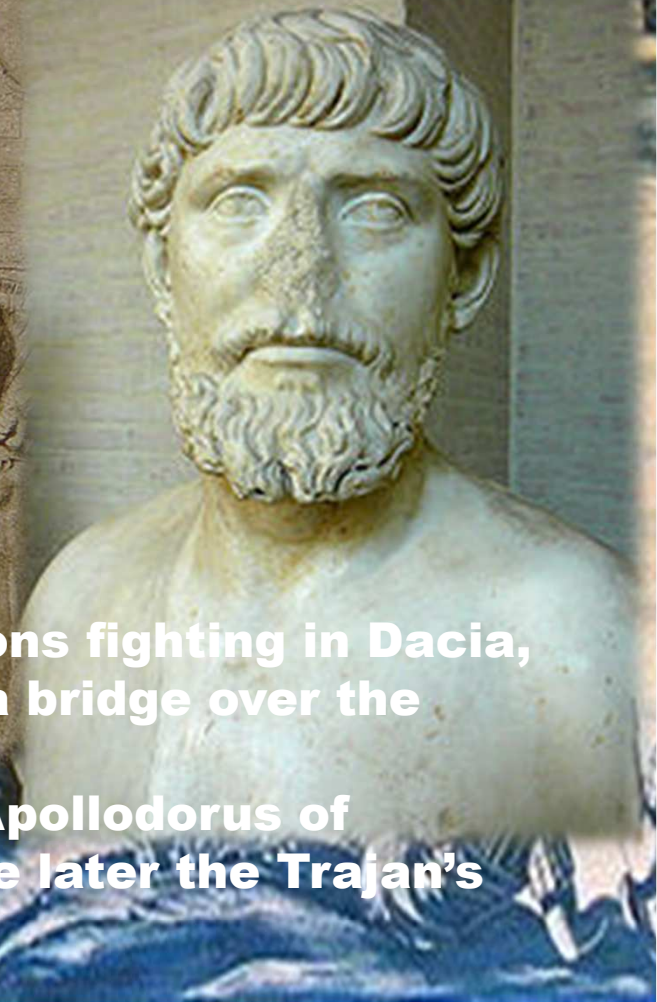
Trajan's Bridge

the world's biggest bridge from antiquity

Relief of the bridge on Trajan's Column

To provide a supply route for the Roman legions fighting in Dacia, Emperor Trajan ordered the construction of a bridge over the Danube.

It was built between 103 and 105 A.D. , by Apollodorus of Damascus, the greek architect who will make later the Trajan's Column in Rome.

It is placed in the archeological park, where are found the ruins of Drobeta Castrum and the Trajan's Bridge Foot. The museum has a Danubian fish aquarium and holds the most complete information on the Iron Gates National Park.

The Cultural Palace “Theodor Costescu”

In the center of the city we can see the most important cultural edifice -the Palace “Theodor Costescu” . It includes large and beautiful halls: theater hall, library, museum, cinema and festivities halls.

Kynethic Fountain “Romanian ring dance from Balacita”

The Kynethic Fountain offers an urban spectacle harmonized with the waves of the Danube.



The "Heroes Monument"



Placed in the Park of Roses , it is a tribute to Romanian soldiers who died in the First World War.
